# PAR-2IMAA <br> User Guide 



## Operation Buttons

| 1 | ON/OFF - Switches between run and stop. The light flashes when a malfunction occurs. |

| 2 | OPERATION MODE SWITCHING - <br> Switches between Cool / Dry / Auto / Fan / Heat <br> Operation modes vary depending on the air conditioning system. Auto mode is dependant on model. |
| 3 | TEMPERATURE SETTING - <br> Sets the room temperature: Range of temperature setting: Cool / Dry: $19^{\circ} \mathrm{C}-30^{\circ} \mathrm{C} /$ Heat: $17^{\circ} \mathrm{C}-28^{\circ} \mathrm{C} /$ Auto: $19^{\circ} \mathrm{C}-28^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$ |
| 4 | FAN SPEED SETTING - <br> Models with 4 airflow speed settings: Hi / Mid-2 / Mid-I / Low Models with 3 airflow speed settings: Hi / Mid / Low Models with 2 airflow speed settings: Hi / Low |
| 5 | AIR FLOW DIRECTION SETTING - <br> Air flow direction angles $100 \%-80 \%-60 \%-40 \%$, Swing, Louver ON/OFF. Air flow direction setting buttons vary depending on the model. |
| 6 | TIMER SELECTION BUTTON - <br> Switches between: Daily timer, weekly timer and auto off timer ( 30 minutes to 4 hours). |
| 7 | This is the Lossnay interlock button. |
| 8 | This sets the current time, timer start and stop times. |
| 9 | This resets the Filter service indication display. |

## Display

| IO | ERROR - When an error is occurring on an air conditioner unit, <br> the affected unit and the error code are displayed. Phone number <br> may also be displayed for maintenance purposes. |

| II | This lamp lights during operation, goes off when the unit <br> stops and flashes when a malfunction occurs. |
| 12 | FILTER DISPLAY - <br> Indicates that it is time to clean the filter. |
| I3 | INDOOR UNIT INTAKE TEMPERATURE - <br> Measures the intake temperature of the indoor unit when <br> the indoor unit is operating. |
| 14 | OPERATION MODE - Displays the operation mode. |
| 15 | TIMERS - Displays the current time and timer set times. |
| 16 | This displays the air direction. |
| 17 | The selected fan speed is displayed. |
| I8 | This displays the selected temperature. |
| 19 | This lamp lights when electricity is supplied to the unit. |
| 20 | SENSOR DISPLAY - <br> Displayed when the remote controller sensor is used. <br> 21 |
| This displays the time and the day. |  |
